How Shared Teaching helps

Shared Teaching lets you share students and courses across multiple schools using Arbor.

- 1 Agree on **shared timetable slots** with your partner schools.
- 2 **Create the shared courses in the Shared Teaching Admin Module** and set which school they're being taught at.
- 3 Push the classes **out to all partner schools' Arbor sites** for enrolment.
- 4 Enrol your students in any course **directly from your MIS**, and your partner schools enrol theirs.
- 5 View shared student information in your MIS. Data is **synced between home and partner schools**, such as attendance, assessments, and medical records.
