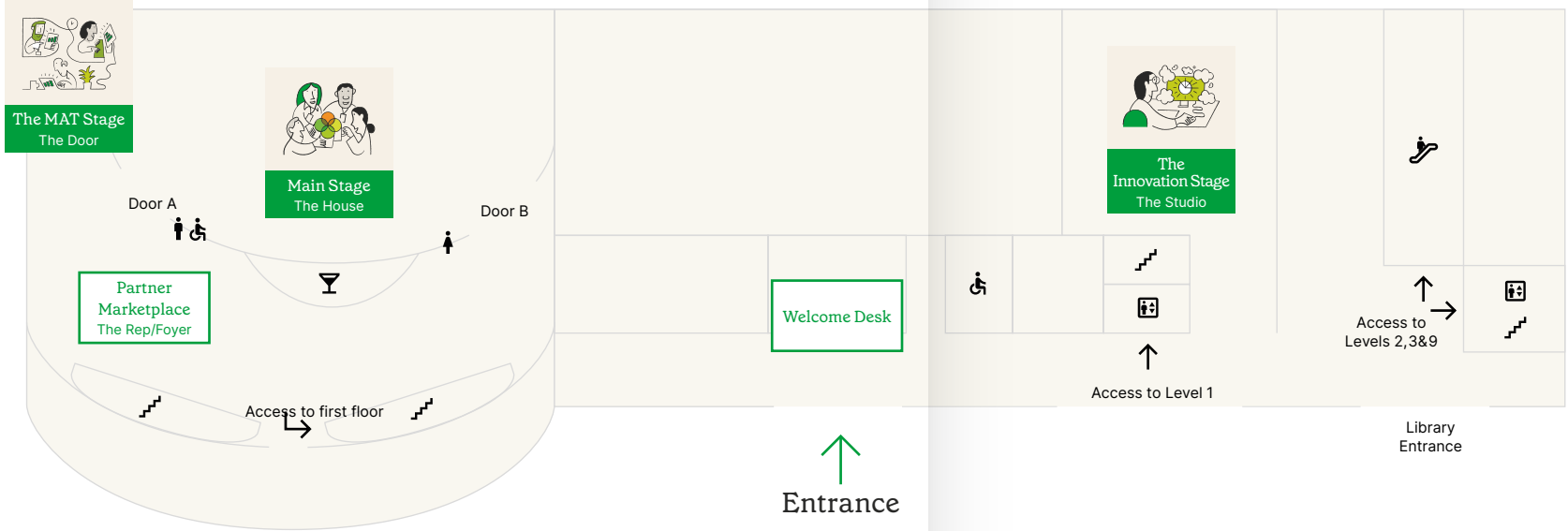

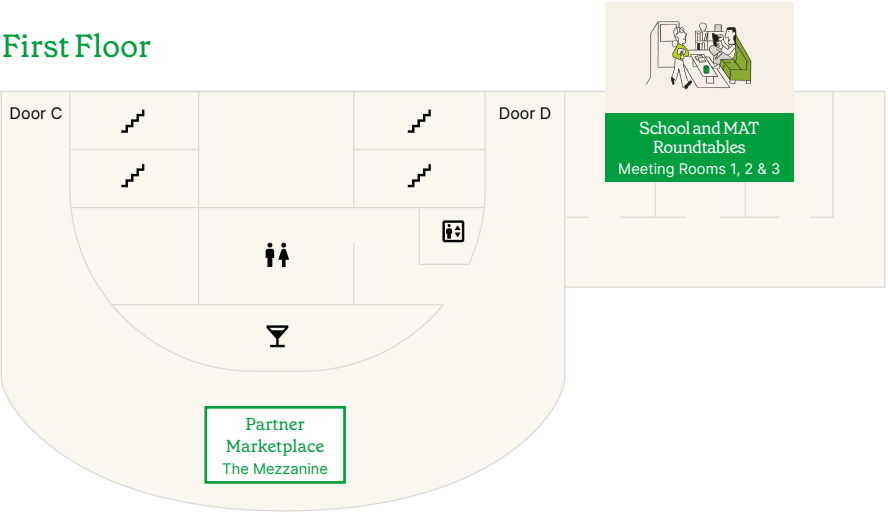

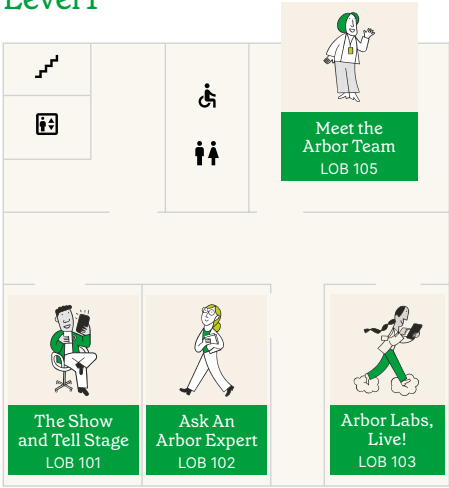

In 2024, the Chief Inspector at Ofsted pledged "real change" to the way Ofsted inspects and regulates schools. As part of their "big listen", Ofsted found that:

47% of professionals said they would be uncomfortable raising concerns with an inspector during an inspection

More than 3 in 5 providers felt inspection placed undue pressure on their workload

Only 28% of providers supported the single word judgement

All of these insights will be used by Ofsted to help reshape and deliver their new framework, due to come into effect in 2025.

We know that single word judgements are being scrapped in favour of report cards, but what else can we expect Ofsted to announce? And how can your school or trust rely on Arbor to best showcase your school under the new framework?

In this special panel, we'll be speaking to Ofsted's Chief Analyst and Director

of Insights and Research, Alex Jones, who will talk on what Ofsted are hoping to get out of this evolution, and what it means for schools. Joining him will be Carly Holness (Assistant Principal at Haberdashers' Borough Academy), Lewis Dinsdale (Headteacher at English Martyrs Catholic Primary) and Tim Mockford (Data Lead at ACE Schools) who will share their on-the-ground insights of how Arbor can directly support with an inspection. Plus, we'll discuss how we can change the culture in schools around Ofsted, with top tips from our panel who have all been inspected recently.

You'll come away with deeper insight and understanding around Ofsted's goals as an organisation, and a set of practical top tips to help your school or trust get inspection-ready using Arbor.

Teaching has been called a 'weakened workforce.' Sweeping numbers of teachers are leaving the profession earlier in their careers, cutting the supply line through to middle management and leadership, and leaving pupils without the qualified teachers they need and deserve. Above all, the supply crisis is harming children's prospects, most

of all the least privileged.

The Teaching Commission aims to identify the causes and solutions to this growing problem. It has been working closely with expert witnesses and produced a report with recommendations for government, and for school leaders, on how to recruit and retain teachers.

In her exciting keynote, Baroness Mary Bousted will share exclusive insights into the work of the Commission and highlight its strongest recommendations to transform teachers' working lives.

This is a crucial conversation to be had, and fitting to round off a day spent thinking about "the future of work in schools."

Attendance has been a headline concern for schools since the pandemic. Not only has persistent absenteeism increased, but so has the absence gap for more vulnerable children.

Some see this as a breakdown of the school-parent relationship, while others look through the lens of students' mental health. In this ArborFest session, we've invited three school and MAT leaders to share how they've turned to their data for answers on absenteeism.

Unlike their predecessors, the Labour government hasn't been pushing MAT growth. Despite this, Schools Week reported in July 2024 that there had been a "boom" in trust mergers.

Quite often, when we talk about mergers, the headlines focus on the impetus for change, policy and the difficulty of completing a deal. But once the papers are signed and two groups of schools are set to become one, how do you actually operationalise a merger?

As well as having two different cultures, schools and trusts will often have disparate systems, embedded digital strategies and particular processes which are unique to their organisation.
