n 2023, when we released the first edition of this report, there had been no net growth in school spending per pupil for the previous 14 years.¹

A year later, funding per pupil is still 9% lower in real terms than in 2009-2010 as a result of cuts throughout the 2000s.² Plus, many schools are still working through the knock-on effects of the cost-of-living crisis, ongoing budget cuts and the Covid-19 pandemic. This has put even more pressure on schools to divert their resources to where it matters most.

We understand in this context that every pound and every minute in school matters, especially given the impact this has on the education workforce. A year on from the first edition, we've put together this updated ROI report to demonstrate how investing in the right Management Information System (MIS) can and should save your school or trust money and time. We'll be looking at these savings not only through the lens of direct cost comparison with other providers, but also through:

- Auditing and consolidating systems
- Eliminating unnecessary maintenance of servers
- Saving time per staff member by removing the burden of admin
- Driving operational efficiency through the quality and depth of your MIS' features
- Reducing workload, positively impacting wellbeing and therefore retention

All of these factors combined should give you both a tangible return on investment for your organisation, and have a measurable impact on student outcomes and staff wellbeing.

I founded Arbor with the belief that having an MIS which is built to support all school staff, drive efficiency and have an unquestionable impact should be a given. I hope after reading this report, you'll see how changing MIS could achieve the same for your school or trust.

Executive summary

We wanted to find out exactly how Arbor saves our community of schools and trusts both time and money. Findings from our survey of over 7,300 Arbor users, combined with those from our annual NPS survey of all school staff who use Arbor, showed that:

How much do schools spend on MIS, on average?

Average spend on

In England, the average spend on an MIS is £10 - £20 per pupil per year, depending on the functionality in the software and level of support. This includes the cost of licenses, software updates, support and hosting, but doesn't include the initial setup and training costs.

- In an average primary school of 200 pupils*, the spend on an MIS is between £2,000 and £4,000 p.a.
- In an average secondary school of 1,000 students*, the spend on an MIS is between £10,000 and £20,000 p.a.
- In an average Multi-Academy Trust (MAT) with 2,800 pupils across 8 schools†, the spend on an MIS is

between £28,000 and £56,000 p.a.

Additional spend on third-party applications

However, when schools also have to purchase additional apps for Assessment, Analytics, Timetabling and Safeguarding, this can mean that spending on MIS stretches to approximately £20-£30 per pupil per year.2

- For an average primary school, this could extend the spend on internal systems to £4,000 – £6,000 p.a.
- For an average secondary school, this could extend the spend on internal systems to £20,000 - £30,000 p.a.
- For an average MAT, this could extend the spend on internal systems to £56,000 - £84,000 p.a.

How schools are eliminating third-party systems with Arbor

We surveyed 397 School Business Managers, Bursars and Chief Operating Officers across MATs, Primary, Secondary, and Special Schools who are using Arbor. We found that these schools are saving money by replacing third-party apps with Arbor's built-in functionality.



Nearly 3/4 (73%) of respondents said they had been able to eliminate at least one third-party system since moving to Arbor





Part 1 Cost savings as a result of moving to Arbor MIS

If we estimate that the average cost of a parent engagement/communications app is a minimum of £1 per pupil per annum:

- The average Primary School (200 students) would eliminate £200 of annual costs on third-party subscriptions by moving to Arbor
- The average Secondary School (1,000 students) would eliminate £1,000 of annual costs on third-party subscriptions by moving to Arbor
- The average MAT (2,800 students across c.8 schools) would eliminate £2,800 of annual costs on third-party subscriptions by moving to Arbor

If we estimate that the average cost of a parent engagement/communications app is a minimum of £2 per pupil per annum:

- The average Primary School (200 students) would eliminate £400 of annual costs on third-party subscriptions by moving to Arbor
- The average Secondary School (1,000 students) would eliminate £2,000 of annual costs on third-party subscriptions by moving to Arbor
- The average MAT (2,800 students across c.8 schools) would eliminate £5,600 of annual costs on third-party subscriptions by moving to Arbor

Given that the majority of our schools were, on average, able to eliminate 2.3 third-party systems by moving to Arbor, and that the majority of these were parent communication and payment applications, we can therefore estimate that, combined:

The average Primary School (200 students) would eliminate £600 of annual costs on third-party subscriptions by moving to Arbor

The average Secondary School (1,000 students) would eliminate £3,000 of annual costs on third-party subscriptions by moving to Arbor

The average MAT (2,800 students across c.8 schools) would eliminate £8,400 of annual costs on third-party subscriptions by moving to Arbor

This doesn't include costs for software updates, support and hosting, initial setup and training, meaning we would estimate that savings would be even higher.

In our previous survey (2023) of SBMs, COOs and CFOs, we also found that the the amount of apps a school or trust had eliminated as a result of moving to Arbor increased by 70% after being an Arbor customer for 24+ months.

We carried out detailed system analysis and realised we were buying into an unnecessary amount of additional systems, simply because our previous MIS didn't support those functions that were necessary to school life: things like assessment of children's progress, school meals, receiving payments from parents, school club provision etc. Back in February 2022, we were having to interface all these additional apps into our MIS, sometimes having to export and import continually to allow for the most up-to-date information. Not only were the additional subscriptions and applications costly, but also labour intensive from an administrative and organisational point of view.

When we looked at what we currently bought into, there was over £19,000 worth of additional subscriptions and costs per annum that we could effectively eliminate by moving to Arbor.

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Since using Arbor, our school has been able to reduce the amount of IT software packages we use, most notably, behaviour, communications and a school payment system — which is actually new for our school.

Bringing these three things into one great system like Arbor saves us time, money and improves staff efficiency immeasurably. We are so pleased that Arbor can offer this type of flexibility and functionality – I just wish it could make a cup of tea and then we'd have the whole package!

Cost-savings per school

Our old MIS was outdated and not particularly user-friendly. We found Arbor to be far more intuitive, and easy to use. The price point was a big draw too – a far more effective use of money.

In our survey of Business Managers, Bursars and COOs, we asked how much money Arbor saves them per year, when considering everything their school or trust spends on software, servers, training and support.



Part 2 Saving time, driving efficiency with Arbor

Our MIS is designed to save all staff time and drive efficiency in your school, so you can spend the time where it matters most

Time saved by different school roles

We surveyed 7,306 Arbor users to find out how much time they save with Arbor per week. On average, we found that:

69% of respondents said that they save time per week with Arbor

84% of headteachers/principals said that they save time per week with Arbor

Of those that said they saved time as a result of using Arbor, our respondents saved, on average, over 70 minutes per week — see how this increases for different roles on the next page

2% of respondents said they saved between 6 and 8 hours a week, equivalent to one whole school day Areas that were quoted as saving schools and trusts time included:

- Day-to-day tasks such as following up on attendance and reporting
- Bigger tasks, namely the Census
- Intuitiveness of the system means less time training staff or waiting on support
- When support is needed, the efficiency of our Support Team saved respondents time



Arbor has been an incredible investment. It saves time every day. We find it easy to use, easy to train staff to use, it assists with absence tracking, staff contract calculations and the logging of SEN / behaviour etc (all previously paper / admin tasks). Arbor's deeper functionality, and connecting those dots across the system, relieves the administrative burden on school staff, which in my opinion, gives staff the capacity to concentrate on those higher value activities. Those things you might not always have the day-to-day bandwidth to support.

We can put more of our energy into doing things that benefit our wider community, help our families, or even simple things, like increasing our tours and marketing to make sure we receive the maximum amount of funding that we are eligible for. Because if your numbers are below pan, you've still got to staff the same classrooms, which puts the students at a disadvantage. So for me, marketing and lettings and generating additional income to supplement the school budget is critical, because it impacts student outcomes. With the right MIS, you can free up some of the administrative capacity to manage that.

The reason we moved to Arbor was that we wanted to simplify some of our work processes in order to save time. Our previous cloud MIS was so clunky, and there wasn't any easy visibility into our data. Improving wellbeing by reducing admin

Every year, thousands of people start a career in schools to make a difference. But at the same time, even more of them leave. The #1 reason for staff leaving the profession is workload, closely followed by stress.

At Arbor, our MIS is designed to reduce workload by automating laborious admin work. As well as simply saving schools time and driving efficiencies, we hear directly from our community of schools that this:

 outcomes



You want to keep things interesting for people, which supports staff engagement too. Certain things have to happen at certain times in schools, and some of the more labour intensive work can be more monotonous, which causes peaks and troughs in terms of individual workload, particularly when we were dependent on lots of manual processes. Arbor is helping us to level off those peaks effectively.

Of course, we're still busy, but not to the point where people are completely overwhelmed and where work is more interesting that supports staff development, recruitment and retention.

It's evident Arbor's developers have a real understanding of education. As the old saying goes, time is money, and whilst it may not ring true for some educators, time is directly related to wellbeing so moving to Arbor has had a positive impact on a significant number our staff's wellbeing and mental health.

Driving efficiency through joined-up working

It's not as easy as "saving time = saving money" in education, as the ultimate aim of your organisation is not to make money, but to help create the best outcomes for your students as possible.

Our MIS is designed to do the heavy lifting when it comes to timeconsuming manual tasks, so that staff have more time to spend on work that:

- Drives school improvement
- Drives school efficiency
- Has a tangible impact on the lives of your pupils

The total spend on 5–16 year olds in England is £7.5K per year, per student, meaning the cost of MIS and related apps make up less than 0.5% of schools' total spend.¹

By contrast, schools spend 10x more on their admin and clerical staff than their MIS.² This means schools should be making sure that the tools used by these staff are designed to help make them make the most effective use of their time and energy.



Unquantifiable savings


Many of the responses in our survey and interviews quoted savings that couldn't be explicitly quantified, although they still created positive impact across schools and trusts. These include, but aren't limited to:

- Costs of maintaining a server e.g. air conditioning, other maintenance costs
- Time lost to bulky updates and errorfixing
- Time lost to staff having to come into school when they couldn't access data from home
- Time lost on the phone to often unavailable support
- Time lost to figuring out workarounds in an unwieldy and clunky system





Methodology

We carried out two surveys for this report.

Survey 1 was sent to 7,225 School Business Managers, Bursars and Chief Operating Officers. 397 participants took part in the survey (5.5% of those contacted), with 83% of respondents completing the survey in full and the rest answering some of the questions but not all. Participants were given from 23 May 2024 to 7 June 2024 to take part.

Survey 2 was sent to 204,311 Arbor users, including SLT, teachers, office staff, and trust central teams. 6909 participants took part in the survey (3.4% of those contacted), with 86% of respondents completing the survey in full and the rest answering some of the questions but not all. Participants were given from 23 May 2024 to 7 June 2024 to take part.
